

BYLAWS

OF

ARKANSAS COLLISION REPAIR ASSOCIATION

As Amended at State Meeting April 26, 1997

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Arkansas Collision Repair Association.

ARTICLE 11 - OFFICES

1. Registered Office. The registered office of the corporation shall be: Wallace Associates, 1301 S. Scott, Suite 204, Little Rock, Arkansas 72202.
2. Other Offices. The corporation may also have offices at other places as the Board of Directors may determine or as the business of the corporation may require.

ARTICLE III - OBJECTIVES AND PURPOSES

1. To promote public awareness of the need for trained personnel in the auto collision repair industry;
2. To promote professionalism in all facets of the collision repair industry while at no time discussing pricing or personalities;
3. To promote integrity and continuity between all parties involved in the collision repair industry;
4. To assist members of the corporation in keeping up to date with all new technology and advances in the auto collision repair industry;
5. To provide visual and instructional materials to members of the corporation;
6. To provide assistance to members of the corporation in an ongoing effort to provide the driving public with safe quality repair of vehicles; and
7. To conduct or support any other activities related to the improvement of the auto collision repair industry and/or the delivery of all services in said industry, provided that this association will conduct or support only such activities as may be properly conducted or supported by an organization described in Sec. 501(c)(6) of the United State Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE IV - STRUCTURE & MEMBERSHIP

1. Structure.
 - (A) The voting members shall constitute the governing body of the corporation and shall exercise supervision, control, and direction of the corporation's affairs, determine the corporation's policies or changes thereof within the purposes as set forth in these Bylaws.
